Day 1

Depart Canada

Depart Toronto via Washington DC (Dulles) or New York (JFK) on your South African Airways flight to Cape Town, via Johannesburg. The tour then winds its way along the legendary Chapman's Peak Drive, hugging the cliffs and relishing the breathtaking ocean views. Day 6

Cape Town/Johannesburg/Hoedspruit

After breakfast this morning you will be transferred to Cape Town Airport for your flight to Johannesburg and then onto Hoedspruit.

On arrival in Hoedspruit you will be met and transferred to your safari lodge.

Set on the banks of a tranquil lake encompassed with breath-taking views of the African bushveld, **Thornybush Waterside Lodge** in the Thornybush Nature Reserve is adjacent to the Greater Kruger National Park. The 20 comfortably appointed air-conditioned thatched suites at this lodge blend into the natural habitat and are located along pathways surrounded by an abundance of trees and manicured gardens.

The accommodation is tastefully decorated and boasts crisp white bedding, en-suite facilities with a separate bathtub and shower, a mini-bar, hairdryer, safe, a tea and coffee station and a private deck.

Arrive Canada

ARRIVE WASHINGTON (DULLES) or NEW YORK (JFK) and connect to Toronto.

- **Passports:** Please ensure that you are in possession of **a valid passport** with at least **TWO BLANK PAGES** marked **"VISA"** and that this is valid for **at least 6 months** after your intended return date from South Africa. If you are visiting other countries, please establish entry requirements and have additional blank visa pages for those countries as well.
- **Malaria:** We strongly advise you to take **precautions against malaria** prior to the commencement of your holiday if you are visiting an area where malaria is found – this included the Greater Kruger National Park area incorporating the Sabi Sands, Thornybush, Timbavati and other private game reserves. Please contact your physician or travel clinic for advice as to which prophylactic is recommended.
